

## UNION BAPTIST CHURCH: GARDEN OF LIFE

---

The Union Baptist Church “Garden of Life” was dedicated June 17, 2001 as a place for celebration, meditation, and a final resting-place for cremated remains. Barbara McLeod made this area possible by the generous donation of land. The beautifully landscaped area includes a bronze plaque for the names of the Church members whose ashes remain in the garden. A walkway with engraved granite bricks celebrates designated individuals or families both living and deceased.

The Garden of Life offers an alternative to other burial options and provides a contemplative setting where all can enjoy a peaceful moment. A committee under the auspices of the Trustees oversees its maintenance in perpetuity.



## GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE GARDEN

---

The Garden of Life is governed by and subject to the following rules and it is suggested that families considering burials there decide in advance whether these limitations meet with their complete acceptance.

- Burials shall be available to the Union Baptist Church community.
- Only a designated Committee member may turn over any earth in the Garden for the placing of ashes and once placed in the ground these ashes may not be removed. Containers will not be buried with the ashes.
- Engraved bronze nameplates of those interred in the garden will be affixed on the plaque. No other decoration of the Garden will be permitted.
- The Committee will set a one-time fee to cover the costs of the burial. The cost for Union Baptist Church members will be \$50.00. All non-members will be \$100.00.
- The minister and the next-of-kin shall determine time for interment.
